METHODOLOGY : The project, addressed to teachers, pupils and families, must be based on several methodological principles that we point out below:

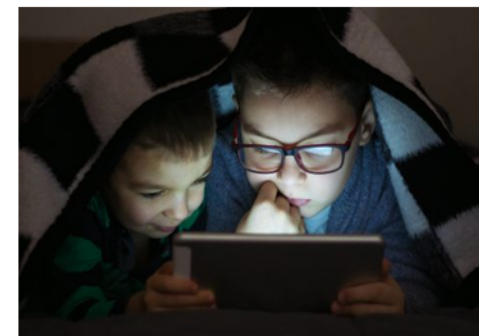
ACTIVE: All the members of the educational community and the European partners must actively participate in the different tasks, workshops, trainings and activities.
